Ch d'Antugnac, Las Gravas 2007 Limoux Blanc 16 Drink 2010-12

100% Chardonnay. From Collovray et Terrier of the Mâconnais.

Quite rich and creamy on the nose and then with fine acidity. Not so different from a fine Mâconnais white! Energy but a little too toasty for real refinement perhaps.

Dom Antugnac, Côté Pierre Lys Pinot Noir 2007 Vin de Pays de la Haute Vallée de l'Aude 15.5 Drink 2010-11

Pale crimson. Really smells like burgundy! Down to the slight domination of the fruit by lightly rustic barrels. Light and fresh and bone dry. Difficult to see this as essentially Limoux though. Quite challenging to taste. !

Dom Antugnac, Aux Bons Hommes 2007 Limoux Rouge 17 Drink 2010-15

70% Merlot, 20% Syrah, 10% Cabernet Franc

Seems quite developed on the nose for a 2007. Dense and yet lively. Very fresh and approachable even at this early stage. High-altitude influence with real grace. Clever stuff. Great balance.
