“Displays the obvious contribution of small oak barrels from lanolin and resin that along with ripe pineapple, lemon, and lily-of-the-valley scent the nose. With an impressive combination of brightness and grip, this nonetheless leaves a bit too much oak behind its finish to really offer either thirst-quenching satisfaction or mineral and floral nuance. I am sure this will keep satisfactorily for at least a couple of years, and perhaps a better balance and more interest will emerge
