



2007 Limoux “Aux Bons Hommes”

“Under the Château d’Antugnac label, the 2007 Limoux Aux Bons Hommes is quite distinctively delicious. Aromas and flavors of nut oils, smoky black tea, bark, tart black raspberries, and cassis inform a wine that combines density of underlying material with brightness and lift such as one might expect from top-flight Bourgogne, and a salty, chalky finishing savor that reels you in for the next sip. The tannins here are a tad rustic, but follow this wine’s evolution—which may well be fascinating—over the next 2-3 years.”
