With the mushroom risotto:
Saint-Veran 2005, Rives de Longsault, Domaine des Deux Roches

These days it is very difficult to find good white Burgundy at a reasonable price. While this one isn't cheap, it certainly offers

superb value for money – in my book it is better than many wines at twice the price. Being from the southern end of Burgundy, around the town of Macon, this white is quite full-bodied and rich in style. But that's just what you need with a full-flavoured dish like mushroom risotto. The flavours are a beautiful combination of nutty, buttery notes with ripe apple and fresh citrus acidity.
